

JULY 2025 WALKWAY PROJECT UPDATE

THE WALKWAY NOW HAVE TWICE THE IMPACT

Since 1898, the iconic Doubling Point Light has guided Kennebec River mariners and welcomed countless shoreside visitors. Sadly, the distressing September 2023 walkway incident forced immediate closure. Total reconstruction of the access footbridge is necessary to reopen for public benefit. Funding this project is key.







WE'VE MADE HEADWAY

The planning phase of this extensive restoration project is done. All four required government permits and design plans by Calderwood Engineering, have been approved. We've signed a contract with J. B. Leslie Company to begin our important walkway restoration project this September. We have raised the greater part of the revised \$409,500 total project budget!
